

Style guru to run SA workshops

INTERNATIONAL image consultant Chata Romano will be in South Africa during the next few weeks to teach women how to project their personalities through their wardrobes, hair and make-up.

Romano, who has been empowering women for more than 15 years, will be hosting a series of "Glamorous Reality" workshops in Durban, Cape Town, Pretoria and Johannesburg in November and December.

In Durban, the workshop will take place at Suncoast Casino and Entertainment World on November 11.
